

#### Competence-based curriculum framework

#### **High School Diploma**

The high school diploma is earned by completing 24 credits with the following minimum credits in each subject: Language and Literature 4, Language Acquisition 3, Mathematics 3, Sciences 3, Individuals and Societies 3, Arts 1.5 and Physical Education 1.5. All student assessment is criteria-based on a scale from 1 to 7. A grade of 3 or more earns a subject credit towards the High School Diploma.

#### Admissions and ranking

In line with our commitment to diversity, equity and inclusion, admission to Ecolint is open on a space-available basis. Given each student's extraordinary, unknowable and unlimited potential across multiple intelligences and dimensions, we do not rank students.

## **Campus Curriculum**

Years 10-11

### **Pre-IB and IGCSE**

Students intending to pursue the IB Diploma study English, French, History, Geography, Science, Mathematics, Computer Science, the Arts, Physical Education and additional languages and subjects depending on their university plans. Students intending to pursue the Maturité suisse start their study of twelve subjects most taught in French.

### **IB Diploma Programme**

The broad and balanced IB curriculum is made up of six subject groups, all with external exams: Language and Literature, Language Acquisition, Individuals and Societies, Sciences, Mathematics and the Arts. Three subjects are studied at higher level and three at standard level over two years and a core that includes Theory of Knowledge, an Extended Essay and extensive engagement with Creativity, Activity and Service (CAS).

### Maturité suisse

Maturité suisse students study twelve subjects, most taught in French. Exams at the end of Year 12 include Science (Biology, Chemistry and Physics), Humanities (Geography, History taught in English) and Visual arts. In Year 13 exams include French, a second Swiss national language, English, Mathematics, a 'specific' and a 'complementary' option. Students also write an Extended Essay and complete written and oral exams set by the Swiss Federal government.



#### **Ecolint Learner Passport**

Each student receives an Ecolint Learner Passport which captures student learning in a holistic manner through academics and extracurricular activities in line with the seven UNESCO/Ecolint competencies.




