The new Campus Hub is key to unlocking our wider redevelopment plans for La Châtaigneraie. The spaces that are freed up within our Leman, Lausanne and Alps buildings will allow us to transform existing pedagogical spaces and create new Centres of Excellence across multiple disciplines. Bringing together complementary academic subjects, these centres will foster greater collaboration and a transdisciplinary approach to learning, two key elements in ensuring our curriculum remains relevant to the challenges of the 21st century.

We are now at a pivotal moment. A new state-of-the-art hub at the heart of the campus will unlock the potential of the entire site and revolutionise La Châtaigneraie for students, parents and teachers, across both Primary and Secondary.

This is a once-in-a-lifetime opportunity to lay the foundations for a thriving community at La Châtaigneraie for generations to come.

Phase 1: a new Campus Hub

A future-proof space to unlock opportunity

Situated opposite the Primary School, the new Campus Hub will transform the academic, social and wellbeing support we offer students across La Châtaigneraie and forge stronger links between Primary and Secondary.

A haven for collaboration and study

A new, **flexible and multi-purpose student study centre** will foster teamwork, cooperation and communication. Divided into four interlocking zones, the centre will provide dedicated spaces for students to engage in focused, quiet study, alongside spaces for collaboration and socialising. A series of soundproofed pods will provide additional opportunities for small-group discussions, helping to foster the exchange of creative ideas for teachers and students alike. The flexible design of the study centre will echo the best co-working spaces in leading universities and companies, allowing our students to innovate and think big.

"With a space dedicated to collaborative work, our students will be able to make time to work on CAS projects and group presentations and also provide peer-to-peer support in an environment where they have access to charging stations, comfortable seating and flexible room sizes. A thriving and inclusive community

The **multi-functional cafeteria and open spaces** will create a vibrant social hub, **growing capacity from 280 to 450 students at any time**, and providing a welcoming space for parents. Surrounded by outdoor green areas, this space will nurture friendships across schools and foster a stronger sense of identity, unity and belonging at La Châtaigneraie.

A vibrant hub of health, wellbeing and creativity

The space and timetable time unlocked by the Campus Hub will enable children to aim higher in their extra-curricular activities, both in Primary and Secondary. Through it, we'll foster core skills of concentration, performance, discipline, sportsmanship and creativity.

At the heart of the space will be an **outstanding 1,400m² multi-purpose sports and exhibition hall**. Efficient heating, acoustics and a new sprung floor will create a safe, calm and temperate space for children to focus on their physical and mental health and wellbeing. Thanks to new retractable bleachers, over 450 guests can join us to enjoy year-round sports, visual and performing arts shows; attend our prestigious guest speaker events; and celebrate student success.

A specialist fitness room and **flexible combined dance studio and martial arts space** will inspire healthy practices that last a lifetime. We will rebuild a high-specification outdoor **basketball court** to give our teams a competitive edge and we will add seating to allow many more spectators to share in their celebrations.

The creation of **dedicated sound-proofed music rooms** will allow budding young musicians to further develop their art.

A one-stop shop for everyone

The main campus reception will sit at the heart of the Campus Hub, along with a **centralised health centre and key student services**. This seamless and secure flow of people, information and resources will allow parents at both schools to access everything they need in one place.

Primary students will benefit from extra-curricular activities and opportunities across the state-of-the-art facilities.

Pupils across La Châtaigneraie will come together for art and sport, building aspiration and confidence among our Primary students. Together, we'll create a more positive experience for students, teachers and parents across the entire school community.

An exemplar of sustainability

Ecolint is committed to integrating sustainability into the heart of our mission. To model a sustainable future to our students, the building will be powered by **new photovoltaic panels** and utilise green energy from the **existing geothermal installation** in the Geneva building. Its smart architectural design will bathe spaces in natural light and ventilation. Our energy-efficient campus will create a surplus that can be used to enhance learning programmes across La Châtaigneraie.

With support from students and parents, we'll also enrich the natural environment along the Greny, build a new footbridge, and plant 200m² of additional trees on campus.

Phase 2: Centres of Excellence

As plans for the Campus Hub come to life over the next two years, the project will release existing spaces across the Léman, Lausanne and Alps building that we would like to reimagine with the creativity of our school community.

We envisage grouping related academic disciplines together to create Centres of Excellence and foster greater multidisciplinary learning, in line with our pedagogical approach. Our plans currently anticipate the following:

> **Léman**

Centre of Excellence for English, Maths and Music

Key developments will include the optimisation of our Mathematics and Music zones, and the creation of a dedicated Learning Support Services space.

> **Lausanne**

Centre of Excellence for Technology, Science, Performing and Visual Arts

Key priorities will include the creation of new science labs, an expanded Art and Design centre, the relocation of the Design and Technology Department and a new "Maker Space".

> **Alps**

Centre of Excellence for Modern Languages and Humanities

Key priorities will include creating more classroom spaces, optimising modern languages and relocating humanities.

Throughout 2025 and 2026, we will invite you to contribute your ideas to further shape the next phase of these spaces.
