All teachers are experienced in training students to successfully complete ABRSM exams at all levels and giving support to IB music students.

Individual Classes

Enrolment for individual classes in the Music School is a full year commitment. Course fees are invoiced 3 times a year (November, February and May).

Option Year 13

Students in Year 13 have the option to stop courses at the end of Term 1 or Term 2 and will be charged for these terms only. Course fees are invoiced 2 times a year (November and February).

All students registering to study an instrument are automatically enrolled for Instrumental Ensembles and Theory Classes and are billed 40 CHF per term. Theory classes begin October 3, 2016 and finish May 31, 2017. String Ensembles Levels 1 and 2 begin September 20, 2016 and end June 16, 2017. Ecolint students who are not registered for private lessons through the Music School may participate in ABRSM Theory Group Tutoring and String Ensembles if space is available for a fee of 150 CHF per term, placement in the appropriate level and class will be made after the student is registered.

Registration

An online inscription form must be submitted to the Music School Coordinator, Mary Eileen Marie, before any students, new or returning, may begin lessons. The Music School will do its best to honour requests for lessons, teachers, days and times listed on the inscription form. Once a lesson time and teacher has been accepted by the parents, the Terms and Conditions of the inscription form are applied.

General Conditions

The financial commitment is for the full year, i.e. September through June. Only students in year 13 have the option to stop courses at the end of Term 1 or 2 and will be charged at a reduced rate based on their registration. No reduction in fees will be made by the school in case of cancellation or non-respect of the contract, or in case of any absences, withdrawal or dismissal of the student. No lessons are given during school vacations. In the event that a student has to withdraw from their private music lessons for reasons other than force majeure the registration will be cancelled only once another student is available to take the vacated place. Lessons missed by students cannot be replaced and will be billed. In case of a student absence due to a conflict between the scheduled lesson and the scheduling of a mandatory school curricular activity or exam, the missed lesson will be replaced. A written request be sent to the Coordinator 2 weeks in advance of the missed lesson to be considered an Excused Student Absence. In case of a teacher's absence, a replacement lesson will be proposed. However, once a replacement lesson time has been agreed to, the Terms and Conditions of the inscription form are applied. Refusal of proposed replacement lessons will not result in reimbursement. Lessons missed due to a teacher's absence or to an Excused Student Absence where replacement lessons were not able to be given will result in a credit for these lessons. Credits for all lessons are applied in Term 3.

The Music School does not supply instruments. All students should have an instrument available for regular practice.

To maintain children in a safe environment at school, students require adult supervision at all times. Primary students in After School Care will be escorted to and from their private lessons. All Music School lessons are held on the school premises.

No classes are given during school vacations.

THE ASSOCIATED BOARD OF THE ROYAL SCHOOLS OF MUSIC

La Grande Boissière is an examination centre for this world-wide association. Students may prepare for 9 different levels of performance tests ranging from the preparatory test, (corresponding to one year's study) to performance and teaching diplomas. An external examiner conducts the tests and writes detailed comments with suggestions for further improvement.

A certificate is awarded to successful candidates. All instruments including voice can be presented. Students wishing to go beyond the level 5 (Grade 5) must pass the corresponding level in a theory examination. Detailed information is available on the website: www.abrsm.org

Registrations are submitted approximately three months ahead of time in consultation with the individual teacher and the Music School Coordinator. Parents will be billed by the school for inscription fees paid to the ABRSM. The Music School will meet all other administration costs for these examinations.

Registration

An online inscription form must be submitted to the Music School Coordinator, Mary Eileen Marie, before any students, new or returning, may begin lessons. The Music School will do its best to honour requests for lessons, teachers, days and times listed on the inscription form. Once a lesson time and teacher has been accepted by the parents, the Terms and Conditions of the inscription form are applied.

General Conditions

The financial commitment is for the full year, i.e. September through June. Only students in year 13 have the option to stop courses at the end of Term 1 or 2 and will be charged at a reduced rate based on their registration. No reduction in fees will be made by the school in case of cancellation or non-respect of the contract, or in case of any absences, withdrawal or dismissal of the student. No lessons are given during school vacations. In the event that a student has to withdraw from their private music lessons for reasons other than force majeure the registration will be cancelled only once another student is available to take the vacated place. Lessons missed by students cannot be replaced and will be billed. In case of a student absence due to a conflict between the scheduled lesson and the scheduling of a mandatory school curricular activity or exam, the missed lesson will be replaced. A written request be sent to the Coordinator 2 weeks in advance of the missed lesson to be considered an Excused Student Absence. In case of a teacher's absence, a replacement lesson will be proposed. However, once a replacement lesson time has been agreed to, the Terms and Conditions of the inscription form are applied. Refusal of proposed replacement lessons will not result in reimbursement. Lessons missed due to a teacher's absence or to an Excused Student Absence where replacement lessons were not able to be given will result in a credit for these lessons. Credits for all lessons are applied in Term 3.

The Music School does not supply instruments. All students should have an instrument available for regular practice.

An online inscription form must be submitted to the Music School Coordinator, Mary Eileen Marie, before any students, new or returning, may begin lessons. The Music School will do its best to honour requests for lessons, teachers, days and times listed on the inscription form. Once a lesson time and teacher has been accepted by the parents, the Terms and Conditions of the inscription form are applied.

General Conditions

The financial commitment is for the full year, i.e. September through June. Only students in year 13 have the option to stop courses at the end of Term 1 or 2 and will be charged at a reduced rate based on their registration. No reduction in fees will be made by the school in case of cancellation or non-respect of the contract, or in case of any absences, withdrawal or dismissal of the student. No lessons are given during school vacations. In the event that a student has to withdraw from their private music lessons for reasons other than force majeure the registration will be cancelled only once another student is available to take the vacated place. Lessons missed by students cannot be replaced and will be billed. In case of a student absence due to a conflict between the scheduled lesson and the scheduling of a mandatory school curricular activity or exam, the missed lesson will be replaced.
