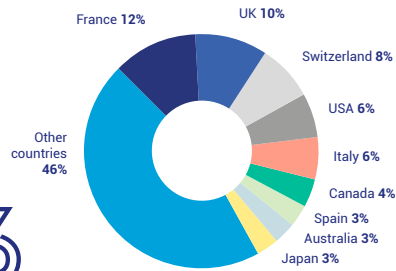

Competence-based curriculum framework

In partnership with UNESCO's International Bureau of Education, we have identified seven competences for all Ecolint students to develop and bring to the world for the common good:

High School Diploma

The High School Diploma is earned by completing 24 credits with the following minimum credits in each subject: Language and Literature 4, Language Acquisition 3, Mathematics 3, Sciences 3, Individuals and Societies 3, Arts 1.5 and Physical Education 1.5. All student assessment is criteria-based on a scale from 1 to 7. A grade of 3 or more earns a subject credit towards the High School Diploma.

Universal Learning Programme

A broad and balanced individualized approach in seven subject groups, most available in English and in French: Language and Literature, Language Acquisition, Individuals and Societies, Sciences, Mathematics, Arts, Physical and Health Education. Students engage in a Passion Project in Year 10, linking their interests to a UN Sustainable Development Goal, and a Mastery project in Year 11, in which they exercise transdisciplinary thinking across subjects to answer a big question related to positive social impact. The Universal Learning Programme drives deep conceptual understanding, assesses life-worthy competences and drives social impact.

IB Diploma Programme

The broad and balanced IB curriculum is made up of six subject groups, all with external exams: Language and Literature, Language Acquisition, Individuals and Societies, Sciences, Mathematics and the Arts. Three subjects are studied at higher level and three at standard level over two years and a core that includes Theory of Knowledge, an Extended Essay and extensive engagement with Creativity, Activity and Service (CAS). Most subjects can be taken in English or in French. The majority of students take the full IB diploma, including the examinations, and graduate in Year 13. Some sit individual IB exams to earn one or more subject certificates, or choose to graduate with a High School Diploma.

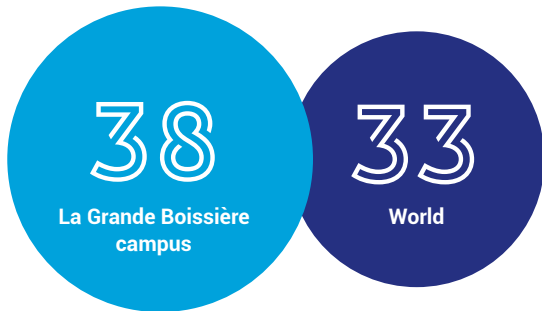

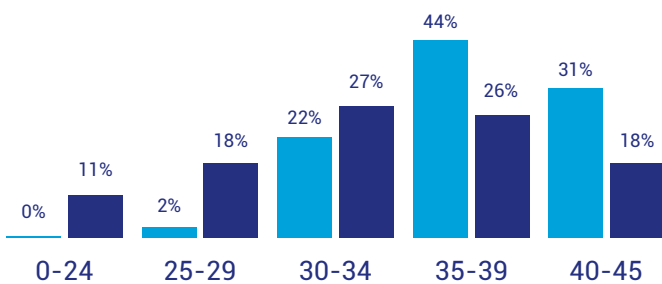
World

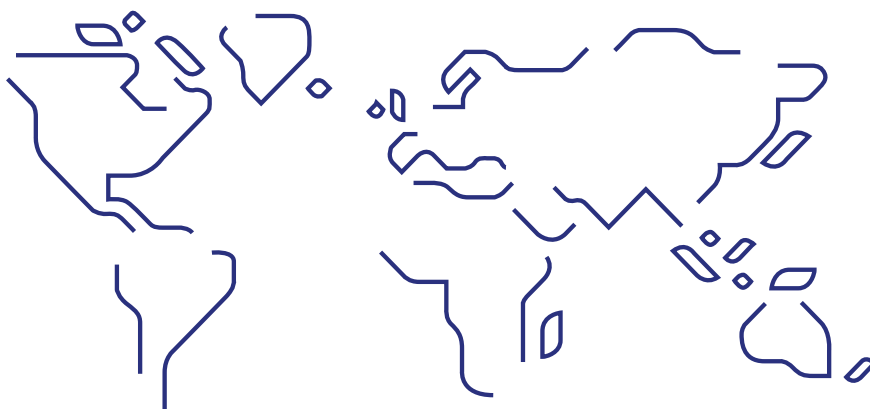
